



Prof Mahesh Tandon, FNAE, Chairman of Tandon Consultants Pvt Ltd has been conferred with the Lifetime Achievement Award of Consulting Engineers Association of India on January 10, 2025 in recognition of his innovative, aesthetic and environmentally sensitive designs in projects acclaimed both in India and internationally. He significantly advanced bridge technologies in India, including segmental and integral construction, long-span structures and metro systems. He was also part of the Indo-US expert team for Delhi's earthquake safety initiative under the UNDP Programme and has contributed to international projects in countries such as Malaysia, Singapore, Jordan, Iraq and Algeria among others, including work for the World Bank and Asian Development Bank.

Prof Tandon served as an INAE Distinguished Visiting Professor at IIS Kanpur, Roorkee and Gandhinagar during 2005 to 2015 and continues as a Guest Professor at IIT Gandhinagar (2017-2025). He has received numerous awards including the IIBE Lifetime Achievement Award (2024), IRC Lifetime Achievement Award (2024), IRC Lifetime Achievement Award (2020), UKIERI Honors (2019), IIT Roorkee Distinguished Alumnus Award (2018) and ICI Lifetime Achievement Award (2008). He chairs IRC Committee on Concrete and Cable- Stayed Bridges (2014-2024) and the Research Council at CSIR-CRRI (2023-2025). Previously, he chaired the Research Council at CSIR-CBRI (2020-2023). Prof Tandon remains dedicated to inspiring future generations to pursue Civil Engineering as a preferred field of study and profession.
